EDUARDO MARTURET



duardo Marturet enjoys an active career on three continents; he is the Music Director and Conductor of The Miami Symphony Orchestra and continues to guest conduct actively in Europe. He has made more than 60 CDs that range from the Brahms complete symphonic cycle to surveys of Latin America's greatest orchestral composers.

European orchestras with which has had an active guest conducting relationship include Berliner Symphoniker, European Community Chamber Orchestra, Staatsphilharmonie Rheinland-Pfalz. RAI Symphony Orchestra, Danish Radio Symphony, Royal Flemish Philarmonique, Nordwestdeutsche Philharmonie, Gelders Orkest, Bohemian Chamber Philharmonic, Budapest Radio Symphony, Brabant Orkest, and Concertgebouw Chamber Orchestra in Amsterdam. In 2001, he led the Berliner Symphoniker on a 12-concert tour, sponsored by Deutsche Bank, of major South American cities including Caracas, Sao Paulo, Cordoba, Montevideo, Buenos Aires, Mexico City and Monterrey.

Born in Caracas, Marturet studied in Cambridge, England where he became firmly rooted in the European tradition, obtaining a degree in Piano, Percussion, Composition and Conducting which he studied with Brian Thomas, Franco Ferrara and John Carewe.

He made his Asian debut with the Seoul Philharmonic in 2003, a year when he also opened the Chorin Summer Festival in Berlin and made his debut with the Buenos Aires Philharmonic in Argentina and the Florida Philharmonic in Miami. In 2006, Maestro Marturet received a Latin Grammy nomination in the category of Best Classical Album, for conducting the Berliner Symphoniker in "Encantamento."

Since 2006 he has been the Music Director and Conductor of the Miami Symphony Orchestra, during his 16 year tenure Maestro Marturet has taken MISO into the world-class professional symphony of Miami developing a unique classical-crossover repertoire in alliance with great producers such as Emilio Estefan, Rudy Perez and Burt Bacharach.

In October 2012, he was named one of the "100 most influential latinos in Miami". The ceremony was performed by Fusionarte Association, Pan-American Foundation and Televisa publishing. This same year, in March, the flag of the United States was flown over the U.S. Capitol in honor of Eduardo Marturet, who received the Medal of Merit of the U.S. Congress in recognition for his outstanding and invaluable service to the community.

In 2019, was inducted into the Genius 100 Visions Group, "an active and engaged community of 100 exceptionally imaginative and impactful human beings. Genius 100 brings accomplished and compassionate minds together to re-imagine the future – and to implement creative initiatives to improve it.

More recently, he was part of a historic event that took place on Sunday, Mar. 14, Einstein's birthday, when Astronaut Dr. Soichi Noguchi (JAXA, Japan Exploration Agency) was inducted as a Genius 100 Visionary. During this historic event, Planet 9, an opus Maestro Marturet composed exclusively to be performed in space, was performed for this occasion. Marturet and many other Genius 100 Visionaries took part in this once-in-a-lifetime experience.

Maestro Marturet became a Steinway Artist in 2014.

DANIEL ANDAI



Hailed as an "Exemplary Leader" by the New York Times for leading members of New York Philharmonic and Manhattan School of Music in Carnegie Hall, violinist Daniel Andai has shared his versatile artistry as a soloist, recitalist, chamber musician, concertmaster, conductor and recording artist in major concert venues in over 50 countries. He is a prizewinner of numerous competitions and soloed with orchestras around the world.

Daniel Andai was concertmaster and frequent soloist of the Philharmonic Orchestra of the Americas in New York with whom he recorded multiple Billboard rated SONY Classical CD's. He has guest conducted, performed as soloist, and held the concertmaster position with the Miami Symphony Orchestra (MISO) since 2010. He has appeared as guest concertmaster with orchestras in Mexico, Brazil, Switzerland, and France, performed in the sections of New York Philharmonic and Miyazaki Festival Orchestra (Japan), and worked closely with members of major string quartets, symphony, opera, and ballet orchestras from around the world.

As an educator, he brings a multifaceted style of teaching, suited for students of all ages and competencies. He connects with students by harnessing critical thinking, passion, and energy, to inspire skillful artistry. The greatest impact to his students is found in the creative interlacing between technique and self-confidence. By facilitating his students' creative development, he believes they can find ways to transfer skills between a music career or to an array of other workforce areas to help them best serve their communities.

RODNER PADILLA



3 times Latin Grammy Winner, 1 time Grammy Nominee Venezuelan bassist, composer, arranger and music producer.

In 2014 won his first Latin Grammy for his role as musician, producer and engineer on his very own group's album, C4 Trio + El Pollo Brito, "De Repente", one out off two nominations that year; in 2019 he won two Latin Grammy on "Best Arrangement" and "Best Folk Album" for "Tiempo al Tiempo" by Luis Enrique + C4 Trio, where he holds credits as band leader, producer, arranger, engineer and performer.

He also Co-produced the 2013 Latin Grammy Nominee Album, "Gualberto + C4" by C4 Trio and the legendary Venezuelan singer, Gualberto Ibarreto.

In 2018 he was nominated for the Recording Academy Awards (NARAS), on the album "Pa' Fuera" by C4 Trio + Desorden Publico". His intensive activity as a bassist earned him international awards, including Latin Grammy in 2011, with the "Treasures of the Music" Venezuelan from famous Venezuelan artist Ilan Chester, in the category "Best Folklorico Album". He also won The Joropo International Tournament in Villavicencio, Colombia, in the category of "Best Ensemble New Format" with C4 Trio and "Best Bassist".

As a multi-instrumentalist. he had recorded Piano, Keybords, Melodica, Double-bass and Acustic Guitar in several productions for great artists, such as Rafael 'el Pollo' Brito, Frank Quintero, Jose Luis Quintana 'Changuito', Judy Buendia, María Alejandra Rodríguez, C4 Trio and many live performances.

Padilla has been on several international tours visiting and performing in Estados Unidos. Francia, España, Italia, Alemania, Bélaica. Inglaterra, Escocia, Holanda. Marruecos. Canadá. Colombia, Ecuador, México, Costa Perú. Cuba and other countries from Latin American and the Caribbean. He has also traveled Venezuela around dictating workshops about contemporary harmony as well as execution and improvisation of electric bass. In 2010, he was invited along with his group, C4 Trío, for giving a concert some lectures prestigious Berklee College Music in Boston, as a part of their USA tour.

YOONIE HAN



Praised for her "flowing tones, poetic phrasing and heavenly singing melodies" (Cincinnati Inquirer), and "musical imagination and feel for complex textures that drew vivid images" (Washington Post), South Korean pianist Yoonie Han has won top prizes in distinguished international competitions and the highest accolades for her poetic performances in major concert halls around the world.

In 2009, Yoonie Han was honored with the Gawon Music Award as the "most brilliant pianist aged 17 to 31 of any nationality who possesses the most promising potential for global prominence." She is the first-prize winner of the Washington International Piano Competition, Fulbright Concerto Competition, World Piano Competition, Kosciuszko Chopin Competition, Juilliard's Gina Bachauer Piano Competition, Juilliard's Frederich Nordmann Piano Competition, Juilliard's Chopin Piano Competition, Music Teachers' National Association Piano

Competition, and has garnered major prizes at the Helsinki Maj Lind International Piano Competition, Arturo Benedetti Michelangeli Prize, Concorso Pianistico Ettore Pozzoli Internaziole, and Valencia International Piano Competitions. Following her 2001 grand-prize award in the Korea National Music Competition, the Korean Ministry of Culture named her its "Most Promising Young Artist."

Master of Music degree from the Juilliard School, and her Doctorate from Stony Brook University. She is the Artistic Director of the Istanbul International Piano Festival and Steinway Prize. She is currently an Assistant Professor of Piano at Hong Kong Baptist University.

KAREN LEFRAK



A native New Yorker, composer Karen LeFrak began playing the piano at age three. Her works have been performed by leading ensembles and musicians at prestigious venues in the US, Europe, Russia and Asia. Recent performances include her ballet Gentle Memories, at the Koch Theatre and main stage of the Mariinsky Theatre in Saint Petersburg, the ballet Tous Les Jours, at the Moscow Kremlin, her oboe and horn double concerto with New York Philharmonic principals Liang Wang and Philip Myers with the Shanghai Symphony Orchestra, the world premiere of A Bite of the Apple with the New York Philharmonic, and Windy Sand by the Joffrey Ballet both in Chicago and at the Koch Theatre and the world premiere of the ballet Pavlovsk at the Mariinsky Theatre in Saint Petersburg, Russia.


