EDUARDO MARTURET



duardo Marturet enjoys an active career on three continents; he is the Music Director and Conductor of The Miami Symphony Orchestra and continues to guest conduct actively in Europe. He has made more than 60 CDs that range from the Brahms complete symphonic cycle to surveys of Latin America's greatest orchestral composers.

European orchestras with which he has had an active quest conducting relationship include Berliner Symphoniker, European Community Chamber Orchestra, Staatsphilharmonie Rheinland-Pfalz. RAI Symphony Orchestra, Danish Radio Symphony, Royal Flemish Philarmonique, Nordwestdeutsche Philharmonie, Gelders Orkest, Bohemian Chamber Philharmonic. Budapest Radio Orkest, and Concertgebouw Chamber Orchestra in Amsterdam. In 2001, he led the Berliner Symphoniker on a 12-concert tour, sponsored by Deutsche Bank, of major South American cities including Caracas, Sao Paulo, Cordoba, Montevideo, Buenos Aires, Mexico City and Monterrey.

Born in Caracas, Marturet studied in Cambridge, England where he became firmly rooted in the European tradition, obtaining a degree in Piano, Percussion, Composition and Conducting which he studied with Brian Thomas, Franco Ferrara and John Carewe.

He made his Asian debut with the Seoul Philharmonic in 2003, a year when he also opened the Chorin Summer Festival in Berlin and made his debut with the Buenos Aires Philharmonic in Argentina and the Florida Philharmonic in Miami. In 2006, Maestro Marturet received a Latin Grammy nomination in the category of Best Classical Album, for conducting the Berliner Symphoniker in "Encantamento."

Since 2006 he has been the Music Director and Conductor of the Miami Symphony Orchestra, during his 16 year tenure Maestro Marturet has taken MISO into the worldclass professional symphony of Miami developing a unique classical-crossover repertoire in alliance with great producers such as Emilio Estefan, Rudy Perez and Burt Bacharach.

In October 2012, he was named one of the "100 most influential latinos in Miami". The ceremony was performed by Fusionarte Association, Pan-American Foundation and Televisa publishing. This same year, in March, the flag of the United States was flown over the U.S. Capitol in honor of Eduardo Marturet, who received the Medal of Merit of the U.S. Congress in recognition for his outstanding and invaluable service to the community.

In 2019, was inducted into the Genius 100 Visions Group, "an active and engaged communityof100 exceptionally imaginative and impactful human beings. Genius 100 brings accomplished and compassionate minds together to re-imagine the future – and to implement creative initiatives to improve it.

More recently, he was part of a historic event that took place on Sunday, Mar. 14, Einstein's birthday, when Astronaut Dr. Soichi Noguchi (JAXA, Japan Exploration Agency) was inducted as a Genius 100 Visionary. During this historic event, Planet 9, an opus Maestro Marturet composed exclusively to be performed in space, was performed for this occasion. Marturet and many other Genius 100 Visionaries took part in this once-in-a-lifetime experience.

Maestro Marturet became a Steinway Artist in 2014.

DANIEL ANDAI



ailed as an "Exemplary Leader" by the New York Times for leading members of the New York Philharmonic and the Manhattan School of Music in Carnegie Hall, violinist Daniel Andai has shared his versatile artistry as a soloist, recitalist, chamber musician, concertmaster, conductor and recording artist in major concert venues in over 50 countries across five continents, the Middle East, the Caribbean and over 30 United States. He is a prizewinner of national and international competitions and has soloed with orchestras around the world.

Daniel Andai is concertmaster, frequent soloist and guest conductor of The Miami Symphony Orchestra. He was also concertmaster and frequent soloist of the Philharmonic Orchestra of the Americas in New York with whom he recorded multiple Billboard rated SONY Classical CD's, made numerous televised solo appearances and was featured on AeroMexico's inflight entertainment systems. These recordings are continuously aired over the radio worldwide.

He has held concertmaster positions with orchestras in Mexico, Brazil, Switzerland, and France, performed in the sections of the New York Philharmonic and the Miyazaki Festival Orchestra in Japan, and worked closely with members of major string quartets and symphony, opera and ballet orchestras around the world.

Daniel Andai is the Dean of Music at the New World School of the Arts in Miami, Florida and the Artistic Director of the Killington Music Festival in Vermont. Previously, Dr. Andai was the violin professor and The Marialice Shivers Endowed Chair in Fine Arts at the University of Texas in Edinburg after having served on faculties at Miami-Dade College and New World School of the Arts. He holds degrees from the University of Miami, the Manhattan School of Music and Lynn University.

NATI ROMAN



Nati Román is a Argentinian-Venezuelan actress, singer and model. Since her childhood, she has performed important musical theater plays such as: The sound of music (Liesel) Godspell (off broadway play), Chicago (lipshitz) Man of La Mancha and others. You can also enjoy her talent in these Latin American films: El Malquerido Diego Risquez (2016), El peor hombre del mundo Edgar Rocca(2016), Yo mi ex y sus secuestradores Javiera Fombona (2017), Bendito Pecado Marianela Aquilera(2018) and Hotel Providencia Caupolicán (2022)

Awards: United Latino Film Festival Award Bendito Pecado, Narrative Short. (2018) and Premios Algo de Cine, Mejor actriz de reparto El Peor Hombre del Mundo. (2017)

As a composer and singer, in 2019 she released her first album Relatos. Which also has a movie based on her life experience as the daughter of a Brest cancer survivor. On October 2022, Relatos the movie was broadcasted on US National television on one of the best cable networks of the country.

Nowadays, she is stablished in MIAMI and works as vocal coach, actress and she is recording her second album.

In 2014 won his first Latin Grammy for his role as musician, producer and engineer on his very own group's album, C4 Trio + El Pollo Brito, "De Repente", one out off two nominations that year; in 2019 he won two Latin Grammy on "Best Arrangement" and "Best Folk Album" for "Tiempo al Tiempo" by Luis Enrique + C4 Trio, where he holds credits as band leader, producer, arranger, engineer and performer.

He also Co-produced the 2013 Latin Grammy Nominee Album, "Gualberto + C4" by C4 Trio and the legendary Venezuelan singer, Gualberto Ibarreto.

In 2018 he was nominated for the Recording Academy Awards (NARAS), on the album "Pa' Fuera" by C4 Trio + Desorden Publico".

His intensive activity as a bassist has earned him international awards, including Latin Grammy in 2011, with the "Treasures of the Venezuelan Music" from the famous Venezuelan artist Ilan Chester, in the category "Best Folklorico Album", He also won The Joropo International Tournament in Villavicencio. Colombia, in the category of "Best Ensemble New Format" with C4 Trio and "Best Bassist".

As a multi-instrumentalist. he had recorded Piano, Keybords, Melodica, Double-bass and Acustic Guitar in several productions for great artists, such as Rafael 'el Pollo' Brito, Frank Quintero, Jose Luis Quintana 'Changuito', Judy Buendia, María Alejandra Rodríguez, C4 Trio and many live performances.

Padilla has been on several international tours visiting and performing in Estados Unidos, Francia, España, Italia, Alemania, Bélgica, Inglaterra, Escocia. Marruecos, Holanda. Canadá. Colombia, Ecuador, México, Costa Rica, Perú, Cuba and other countries from Latin American and the Caribbean. He has also traveled around Venezuela workshops about dictating contemporary harmony as well as execution and improvisation of electric bass. In 2010, he was invited along with his group, C4 Trío, for giving a concert and some lectures in the prestigious Berklee College of Music

in Boston, as a part of their USA tour.

Born in Venezuela of Spanish parents, Dr. Ed Calle is the 2015 Latin Grammy Award winner for Best Instrumental Album, a five-time Grammy nominee, 2016 Pepsi Music Award nominee for best jazz album, and one of the most recorded saxophonists in history. Ed is featured on more than 1,200 CDs and almost of 9,000 singles with recording royalty including Frank Sinatra, Celia Cruz, Arturo Sandoval, Natalie Cole, Michael Bolton, Cristina Aguilera, Tom Dowd, Phil Ramone, Juan Luis Guerra, Chick Corea, Michael Brecker, Gloria Estefan, Juanes, Greg Allman, Lenny Kravitz, The Bee Gees, George Clinton, David Byrne, Rhianna, David Bisbal, the Pet Shop Boys, Julio Iglesias, and Oscar DeLeon. Calle* currently tours the globe as a featured soloist and with his jazz ensemble*, Mamblue*, Arturo Sandoval*, World Music 5, Miami Saxophone Quartet, Negroni's Trio*, 14 Jazz Orchestra, & the South Florida Jazz Orchestra. Active in and recognized by his community, Dr. Calle's accolades include 2018 South Florida Music Hall of Fame Nominee, www.facultyawards.org Best Professor Miami Dade College (2015), United Teachers of Dade Champion of Education for the Arts and Entertainment (2014), and King of Carnival Miami (2013). Dr. Calle is a tenured Professor of Music Business at Miami Dade College and a frequent guest artist and lecturer at schools, colleges, and universities around the globe. Calle's research focuses on the application of relationships between two of his passions, music and mathematics. Dr. Calle's published research explores the challenges facing American students learning math. Ed lives in Miami with his wife Sari and their three children. Calle's latest live CD/DVD - Ed Calle & Rick Margitza Live at the Open Stage Club - will be released globally on April 10, 2018.
